Ball: 2-piece 142g Kooka Colt Ball (white)

Match Time: Commence at 5.30pm with 5.45pm being the latest to commence play before deducting overs. For every 5 minutes late(after 5.45pm) in starting play 2 overs are taken off the game (1 over is taken off each incides).

Pitch Length: 20.1m (standard length)

Boundary: 50m maximum

Overs: 20 per side

Team: Maximum 13 per match (11 bat/11 bowl &

11 permitted to field at any one time.
Players can be interchanged throughout)

No balls: Ball bounces more than twice before

reaching the batter.

Ball does not pitch on the playing surface. Ball passes the striker above waste height on the full Ball passes the striker above shoulder

height.

Match Due to bad weather and the side batting Result:

second is unable to receive its full allocation of overs, the match shall be decided by the team leading at the end of the last completed over relative to the first innings score. Ie: Team A was 25 after 11 overs but went on to complete their innings, the team batting second must pass the same score at the completion of the same over. Team B must

pass 25 at the competition of the 11th over.

Batting: Players are to retire after reaching 40.

Only the first retired batter may return once the last batter has been dismissed.

The use of helmets is compulsory for all

players under the age of 18.

Compulsory Closure: The team batting first must

cease batting at 7.05pm. If 20 overs are not complete, the team batting second shall be entitled to the same overs completed by the team batting first.

The match will finish as soon as there is a

Bowling: 6 ball overs with no balls and wides to be

re bowled to a maximum 8 balls. Final over must contain 6 legal deliveries Bowlers can bowl a maximum of four

overs

10 consecutive overs to be bowled from

the same end to save time

Fielding: No fielder shall be permitted to field (in

front of the wicket) closer to the batsman than half the length of the pitch from the

Batsman.

Lost Time: Game reduced by 2 balls for every

minute lost.
